“GOLDEN K” AWARD

The Kimball High School National Alumni Association proposed to establish the “Golden K” Award to be presented annually to an outstanding member or chapter of the Association. The recipient of this award must have demonstrated during the preceding year notable contribution to the ideal for which our association was founded. These contributions may be through individual or chapter recognition achievement and efforts. The criteria for earning the award shall be:

1. Individual member or Chapter (thereafter referred to as recipient) must have current membership in good standing with the KHS National Organization.
2. Recipient must have made noteworthy civic or community contributions leading to improved conditions in the geographic area in which they reside.
3. Recipient must have made significant contributions to the continued development of the KHSNAA.

The candidates for the award may not be self-nominated, but may be recommended by the local chapter and/or the national organization.

The National President will establish an award committee, which will receive and be responsible for reviewing and selecting the recipient to the “Golden K” Awards. Winners of the award shall be limited to no more than two consecutive years; after which time there must be a break of at least one year before previous winners are again eligible for consideration.
